



# FORK LIFT TRUCK OPERATOR TRAINING

## CUSTOMER INFORMATION SHEET

The training of Fork Lift Truck Operators is available either at the Training Centre or on an employer's premises.

Training is conducted by RTITB & ITSSAR Registered Instructors to an Approved Programme in accordance with the requirements of the Health and Safety Executive.

Training Centre based courses are undertaken on a Counterbalanced Fork Lift Truck or Reach Truck as applicable. The programme consists of practical/theoretical training covering all aspects of Fork Lift Truck operation.

The Trainees are subject to practical and theoretical tests during the final day of the Course. Successful Trainees are awarded a Certificate of Competence to operate the type of trucks on which they were trained.

Training on an employer's premises will only be undertaken where certain conditions prove suitable and there will be additional costs to the fees quoted below to cover the instructor's expenses, travel, etc. Full details available on request.



## TYPES OF COURSES, DURATION AND FEES\*

### Re-Certification

For the operator whose 'ticket' is over three years old.

1 day £150.00 + VAT (£180.00 inc VAT)

Saturday Re-Certification £250.00 + VAT (£300.00 inc VAT)

### Semi-Skilled Operator – A & Reach Conversion

For the competent operator whose main occupation is using a Fork Lift Truck but has never been trained and tested.

2 days £250.00 + VAT (£300.00 inc VAT)

### Semi-Skilled Operator - B

Similar to 'A' above but where the operator uses a Fork Lift Truck on a casual basis and will require longer time to reach test standard.

2.5 days £300.00 + VAT (£360.00 inc VAT)

### Novice

For the new operator with no previous experience.

5 days £435.00 + VAT (£522.00 inc VAT)
